

8 Mont Blanc and Chamonix Visit _ CHF 280 per person

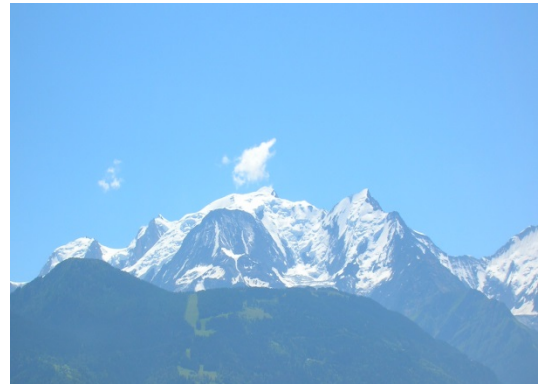
Pre and Post congress excursions

Details of the Tour

The Mont Blanc is the highest mountain in the Alps, Western Europe and the European Union. It rises 4'810.45 m above sea level and is ranked 11th in the world in topographic prominence.



Morning: Chamonix
